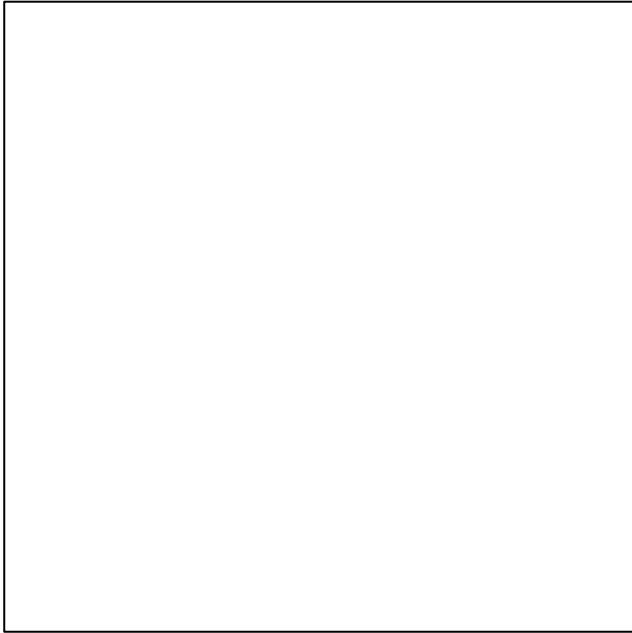
As of 1 January 2017, there were 5,047,028 foreign nationals resident in Italy.

The citizens non-community present on 1st January 2017 are 3.714.137. The countries more represented are Marocco (454.817), Albania (441.838), China (318.975), Ucraina (234.066) e Philippines (162.469).

Between the 1st January and the 30 November 2017 got off in Italy 116.076 people. A datum in decrease compared to 2016, When arrived 173.015 people (-33%).

In November 2017 are 5.371 migrant, less than 13.500 of November 2016. From July to November 2017 arrived 32 thousand migrants, instead of the 100 thousand of 2014, the 73 thousand of 2015, i 114 thousand of 2016.

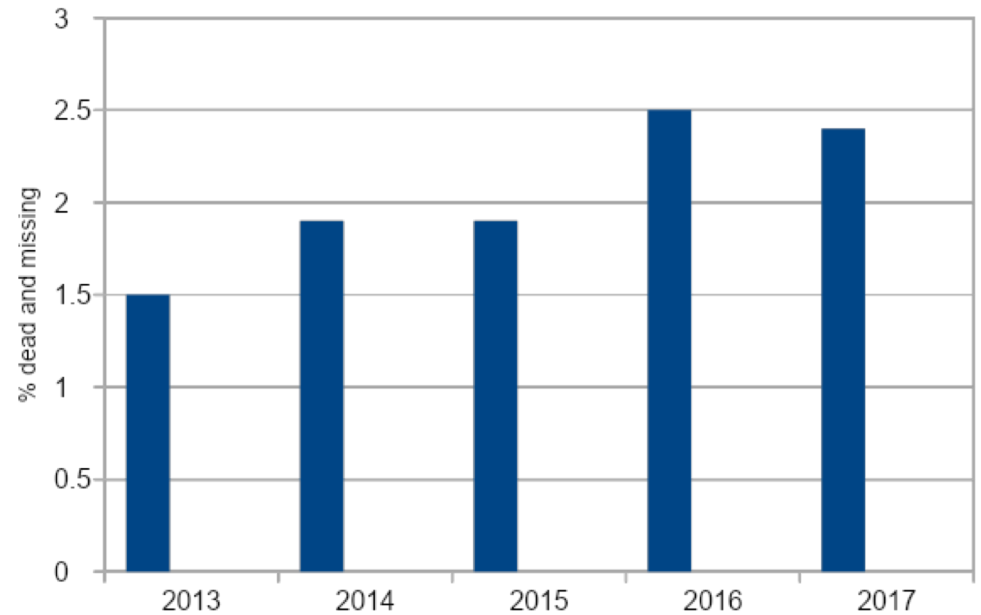
